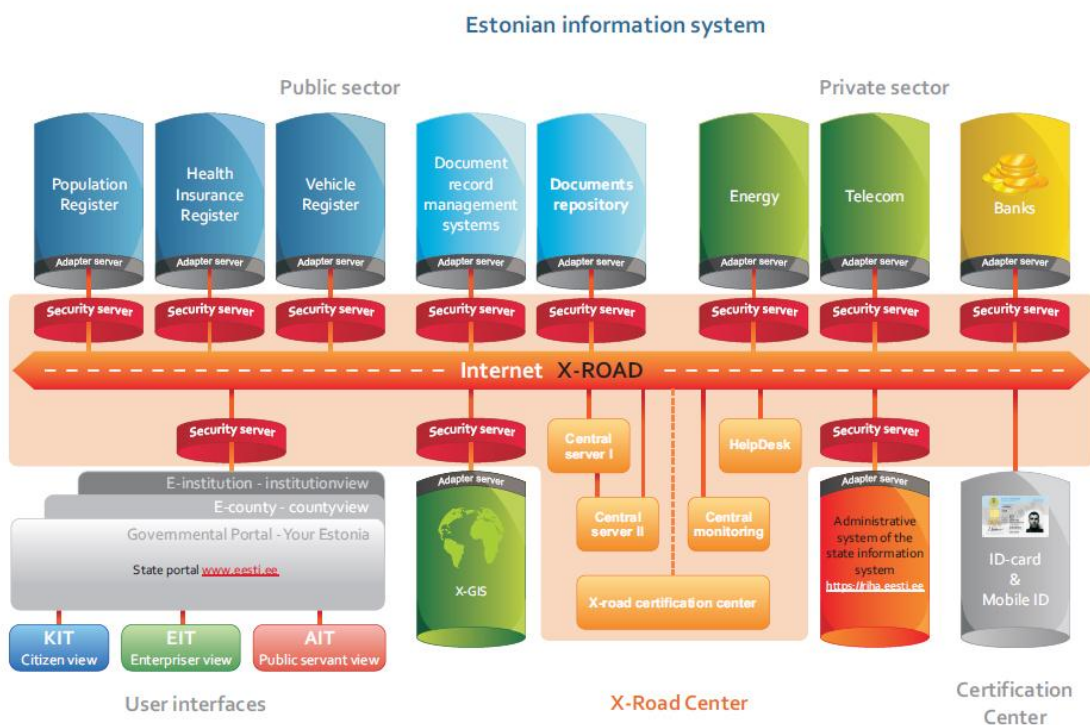
Main topics:
